The meeting was a complete success and and the following objectives were set



During the 1st semester of the INTER-ACT project, activities revolved around the development of the INTER-ACT Book and Assessment Quiz and WP4 INTER-ACT Methodology.

- The team worked together to create the target group questionnaires for Methodology through analysis of the learning needs of students and teachers.
- Each partner collected 20 questionnaire samples from students for the development of Book Concept and 10 questionnaire samples from teachers, for analysing their learning needs related to inclusive education.
- The consortium worked together on Methodology Chapter, consisted of Inter-Act Book's Topics.
